

Dear Youth Pastor,

Prior to Camp:

Each of the included release forms must be filled out. It is required that every attendee has a release form, **youth and leaders**. When completed **and notarized**, these forms must be mailed to us or brought with you to registration (anyone without the form cannot be permitted to attend camp)

These forms include:

- Medical Information and Parental Consent to Emergency Medical Care
- Release of Claims and Hold Harmless Agreement

Please note that any drop after four weeks out from your camp will require a *\$40 cancellation fee* in addition to the \$25 initial deposit. Please understand our desire is to fill all available spots, and last minute cancellations will not allow us the opportunity to fill those spots with individuals that we did not initially have capacity for. Please contact us before arrival for last minute additions.

Registration Day:

Registration is July 12th from 12:00 pm to 5:00 pm:

Upon arrival at camp, bring any notarized forms.

Also be prepared to pay the remainder of your balance, if you have not done so already.

This camp is a first come first serve basis. Our hotel can only accommodate 700 people so please register early. Campers who register after the first 700 will have to stay at a nearby hotel.

Youth Explosion Activities

Sessions:

These are the main focus of camp. Our dynamic speakers will inspire you with the word of God. They will teach you how to stand alone in this world. Along with the speakers is intense Spirit filled worship that will bring you into the presence of God.

The Ultimate Challenge:

These are exciting, unusual and outrageous games all campers get to play during scheduled team times. These activities include: low ropes course, tire-tube slip-and-slide, "the gauntlet", ultimate dodgeball, and more. These are no "regular" camp games and are sure to make your camp experience extreme.

Ministry Opportunities:

This year we want to give youth groups the opportunity to minister alongside of us at camp. Because of this we are asking that if there is a drama, dance piece, or worship song that your youth group would like to use to minister at the camp, please email us at xplosiveyouth@yahoo.com to let us know. We are asking that the group be ready to "addition" this piece before hand at camp so that we can make sure that the piece goes with the flow of the service.

Housing and Food

Housing Accommodations:

All campers will be staying in air conditioned hotel rooms, four to five in each room. Bedding will be provided. Unfortunately, we do not offer married housing at this time, and we do not offer special accommodations for small children either. Also note; **Towels are not provided so please bring your own.**

Food Accommodations:

All meals will be served in our dining hall. All three meals will be served at scheduled times. There will be concessions open during non-meal times, and will serve drinks, candy, ice cream, etc. These are an additional expense, so advise your group to bring spending money if they want extra snacks. We will have a snack bar open nightly after sessions that will have pizza, wings, ice cream and other great snacks. Some of this year's dinners will be catered out; ie Carrabbas, Sonny's Barbecue...

Youth Explosion Rules

To do . . .

- Show up 5 minutes early to all sessions
- Carry an attitude that exudes respect, willingness and servant hood
- Dress appropriately; very modestly (Youth Pastors please help with this)
- Take showers daily
- Bring Bible, pen and camp notebook to each session
- Wear name tag at all times (replacement is \$5.00)

Ladies

1. No bare mid-drifts or spaghetti strap tank tops
2. No two piece bathing suits
3. No Short Shorts or Short Skirts

Gentlemen

1. Must wear a shirt at all times aside from the pool
2. No sagging pants

Staff's discretion will be used regarding appropriate clothing

Not to do . . .

- Violate people or property (threats, verbal abuse, fighting)
- Show Public Display of Affection (PDA)
- Opposite gender wrestling
- Stealing
- Use profanity or racial slurs
- Disrespect authority
- Use tobacco, alcoholic substances, or non-prescription drugs*
- Fight or have weapons
- No guys on girl's floors or in rooms and vice versa
- Have in possession or view pornography
- Leave campus without permission
- Use shaving cream, toothpaste or toilet paper other than what it was intended for
- Bring cell phone to sessions (youth pastors, please have yours on silent ring)
- Wandering away from public areas
- Leave room after in room time
- No guy / girl ministry time i.e. Praying together alone (we need to guard our hearts and avoid any appearance of evil)

Not abiding by the rules of Youth Explosion will result in disciplinary action that could include dismissal from camp at your expense.

Frequently Asked Questions

Youth Pastors

What is my role as the youth pastor at camp?

Let us do the little details so that you can spend time with your group and to get to know them better. During sessions please pray with your youth at any ministry time. Take time at the end of each day to talk about that day's activities.

What will I be doing while my youth group is involved with activities/sessions?

During sessions you need to be present with your group. During games we encourage you to participate to allow your group to foster growth. We keep each youth group together in teams (more than 1 group will be on a team) to allow group growth.

Will I have time to spend with my youth group?

Absolutely! We have youth group times scheduled in so that you can meet with your teens. Please communicate any specific times and activities you want your youth to be present to the staff and they will facilitate this happening.

Do I need to have a lesson prepared for the camp?

No! This camp is designed to give you a break as well as provide a new environment for your youth. But you will want to prepare for ministry time following our sessions.

Can I register at the door?

Yes! Please keep in mind the cost is \$299.00 and the space availability of each camp must be taken into consideration. Anyone registering at the door will need all the forms necessary for camp. You will want to check with prior to coming to be sure there is room.

Frequently Asked Questions (Parents)

Does the cost of the camp cover everything? How much money should I send with my camper?

Everything needed is included: housing, food, sessions, praise and worship, high quality speakers. Extra spending money would be used for concessions, the coffee/smothee shop, and merchandise (like camp shirts).

What is the weather like in Florida?

In the month of July it is usually in the 90's and rain can be expected.

What other activities do you have available?

Pool, Basketball, Beach Volleyball, Intramural Competition.

How can I get in touch with my son/daughter during the camp?
